Booking Conditions

Any contract to hire a holiday home incorporates conditions 1 to 14 below and is between the holiday homeowner and you as the hirer. The contract does not take effect until Ashdown Forest Holidays despatch written confirmation of your booking to you. The Contract is made in England and is governed in all respects by English Law.

1. Hire Terms

All terms are quoted in £ sterling per week for the holiday home equipped as described unless otherwise stated. As soon as the booking is made by you and confirmed by Ashdown Forest Holidays the terms are guaranteed.

2. Number of Persons

The maximum number of persons allowed in each holiday home is shown in the holiday home particulars. Additional persons, except babies in cots where applicable, may not be accommodated. Additional persons may be accommodated at an extra charge. The holiday homeowners reserve the right to terminate the hire without notice and without refund for a breach of this condition.

3. Pets

A pet is allowed for which the normal charge is £15 per week. When you make a booking you must inform us that you are bringing a pet. Record this fact in the appropriate place on the booking form. Dogs must be exercised on a lead. A pet is not allowed on beds or chairs in any holiday home. Dogs must not be left unattended at any time in any holiday home. The hirer will be responsible for any damage or loss caused by any permitted pets at our premises and for the cost of any cleaning. The keeper of the pet in question will be liable for all claims arising from the presence of the pet on our premises. The owners also reserve the right to require inspection of current vaccination certificates.

4. Initial Payment

You must send the initial payment with your booking form. It will be refunded if there is no vacancy for the time you require.

5. Balance Outstanding

You are responsible for the whole of the hire terms. The balance of hire must be paid no later than 42 days before the hire starting date.

6. Booking Cancellation

If you cancel your booking you must immediately notify Ashdown Forest Holidays in writing by first class post, enclosing your Booking Confirmation. We will do our best to re-let the property and if we do, any monies paid will be refunded less a reasonable administration charge.

7. Occupation

Unless otherwise stated in the brochure the normal time of occupation is after 2pm on the hire start date. Occupation before 2pm will not be allowed unless we have given prior permission. If we are prevented by circumstances beyond our control from making the holiday home available and cannot provide a suitable alternative we will refund all monies paid by you but no further liability will be accepted.

8. Departure

The holiday home must be vacated by 10am on the final day of hire and must be left in a clean condition.

9. Minors

Bookings from persons aged under 18 years cannot be accepted.

10. Unsuitable Hirers

Ashdown Forest Holidays reserves the right to decline a booking or to refuse to hand over a holiday home to any person who in our opinion is not suitable to take charge. In this case the hire terms paid shall be refunded in full and the contract shall be discharged without further liability on either party. We reserve the right to repossess the holiday home at any time where damage has been caused by the hirer or any member of the hirer's party, or in our opinion is likely to be caused by the hirer or any member of the hirer's party. In such cases, we shall not be liable to make a refund of any portion of the hire terms paid.

11. Modification and Descriptions

Every effort has been made to ensure that description of the holiday homes is correct. We reserve the right to make modifications to the holiday home specification that are considered necessary in the light of operating requirements. In the interests of continued improvement we reserve the right to alter or delete furniture, fittings, amenities or facilities either advertised or previously available without prior notice. The proprietors reserve the right to make regulations from time to time as to the smooth running of the business of the WHITEHOUSE farm and these will be displayed from time to time in a prominent place.

12. Hirer's Responsibilities

The hirer is responsible for the holiday home and its equipment during the period of hire and is expected to take all reasonable care of it. The holiday home is let fully furnished, towels and dishcloths are included. Bed linen is provided, unless otherwise stated. You are advised to check on arrival and report any shortcomings, damage or missing items immediately to our representative or us so that the matter can be remedied for you. No claim can be considered for such matters not so notified. The hirer undertakes to report and pay for any damage caused to the holiday home or for equipment lost, damaged, broken or stolen during his occupancy of the holiday home. Unsuitable substitutes are not accepted. All the equipment, utensils etc. must be left in a clean condition at the end of the hire period.

13. Hirer's Property

Ashdown Forest Holidays do not accept any liability for loss of, or damage to, personal effects, luggage, motor car, motor car accessories, or any other item belonging to the hirer or to any member of the hirer's party, except in so far as the loss or damage arises from a substantial defect or damage existing in the holiday home or its surrounds and which was known or should have been known to us, but for our negligence.

14. Disputes

Any dispute, difference or question which may at any time arise out of the contract or the subject matter thereof shall be referred to a single arbitrator to be agreed upon between the parties (or failing agreement to be nominated by the President for the time being of the Law Society on the application of either party) in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration Act 1950 or any statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force.

Cancellation Insurance

When you book your holiday you are entering into a legally binding contract. If you are forced to cancel or cut short your holiday for whatever reason, under the law you will be liable for the cancellation charges we may have to make. UK customers can ask us for details of insurance available and enjoy peace of mind. For example on a recent holiday cost of £239 the premium was £11.
